The Principal/Secretary, Noble Ayurved College & Research Institute, & Ayurveda Hospital, Shree Vivek Bharti Trust, Junagadh has applied for the establishment of Noble Ayurved College & Research Institute, Junagadh. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Gujarat has decided to issue **“No Objection Certificate”** to applicant for the establishment of Ayurveda College with 60 (Sixty) seats capacity for starting B.A.M.S Course for the academic year 2017-18.

It is certified that:


1. The applicant owns and manages a 60–beds hospital, which was established in the Year – November, 2014
2. It is desirable to establish Ayurveda College in the Public interest with admission capacity of 60 seats for B.A.M.S. Course.
3. Establishment of Ayurveda College with admission capacity of 60 (Sixty) seats for B.A.M.S. Course at Noble Ayurved College & Research Institute, & Ayurveda Hospital, Shree Vivek Bharti Trust, Junagadh is feasible.

This No Objection Certificate is issued subject to following conditions:-

- (1) The college has to run the course on Self Finance basis and college will not ask for Grant in Aid in future. An Undertaking for this condition must be obtained by Director, Indian System of Medicine & Ayurveda, from the The Principal/Secretary, Noble Ayurved College & Research Institute, & Ayurveda Hospital, Shree Vivek Bharti Trust, Junagadh.

- (2) The college must follow admission Rules and Regulation as well as fee structure as decided by the Government of Gujarat from time to time.
- (3) The College has to follow the Rules and Regulations prescribed by the affiliating University and Central Council of Indian Medicine, New Delhi from time to time.
- (4) The College must fulfill the norms of minimum standards prescribed by C.C.I.M New Delhi from time to time.

It is also certified that adequate clinical material as per norms of the Central Council of Ayurveda is available with the proposed/existing Medical College. It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the Ayurveda College as per Central Council of Ayurveda norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the student already admitted in the College with the permission of the Central Government.
